While I plan on using many different manipulatives and real life “objects”, most of our class work time will be spent using legos. The focus of this class is math, but we will occasionally explore other STEM (science, technology, engineering, and math) concepts. This is a very “hands on” class and each student will be able to build and explore with their own set of legos and/or manipulatives.
